- 1. All participants must be pre-registered with an application completed in its entirety.

- 3. Should two groups enter with the same song, the one with the earliest entry date will be permitted to use that number in the show.
- 4. Only one song may be entered per group or individual performer. Participants may only compete in one act.
- 5. Each performer or group is responsible for bringing their own props. Props should be as mobile as possible so that you can move them on and off the stage easily and quickly.
- 6. Groups/individuals may not enter music or acts performed in earlier Lip Sync contests with the exception of Best of the Best performers.
- 7. Please remember that this is a family show. All music, dances, and moves must be appropriate for people of any age.
