This year's contest will be held on **Saturday, March 17, 2018** at 6:00 PM in the Mifflin County High School auditorium.

ALL ENTRANTS WILL BE COMPETING BY DIVISION ACCORDING TO NUMBER OF APPLICATIONS RECEIVED. ENTRANTS CAN COMPETE IN ONE OF THE FOLLOWING DIVISIONS:

- **LIP SYNC**
- **CREATIVE EXPRESSIONS - Any talent will be accepted as long as it suitable for all audiences- singing, dancing, comedy routine, juggling, etc., either group or individual.**

Prizes will be awarded according to the number of entrants in each division. The criteria used to judge each act are: Costume and/or Set, Originality, Audience Response, Use of Skill-set, Comedy, and/or Drama, Choreography, and Overall Impression.

Anyone wishing to participate should bring the attached application, the \$10.00 registration fee, and their music (if applicable) on CD to Compass Community Connections (aka Mifflin-Juniata Special Needs Center, Inc.), 31 South Dorcas Street, Lewistown. **All music and/or a description/introduction of the act must be included with the application. Your introduction will be used by the emcee to introduce your act and is a good way to get the audience "in the mood" for your number.**

RULES

1. All participants must be pre-registered with an application completed in its entirety.
2. All acts/music for the program must be no longer than **5 minutes total**.
3. Should two groups enter with the same song choice in a division, the one with the earliest entry date will be permitted to use that number in the show.
4. Only one song/act may be entered per group or individual performer. All participants may only compete in one act.
5. Each performer or group is responsible for bringing their own props. Props should be as mobile as possible so that you can move them on and off the stage easily and quickly.
6. Please remember that this is a family show. All music, dances, and moves must be appropriate for people of any age.

Note: Compass Community Connections must approve all songs and acts and reserves the right to reject any performances or limit the number of acts.

Each group/individual will have a scheduled rehearsal time for Saturday morning or afternoon, March 17, 2018 at the MCHS auditorium. You should bring your props and costumes at that time.
